Presenting the Year 2001 City of Davis
Environmental Recognition Award

Whereas, R4 Recycling Program is committed to the delivery of effective, courteous, innovative, and responsive waste reduction and recycling services to the UC Davis Campus;

Whereas, this group's activities include diverting cardboard, paper, glass, cans, bottles, green waste, pallets, inkjet and toner cartridges from the landfill;

Whereas, this group has implemented the use of Mini-bins, Lobby bins, and Classroom Cabinets for maximum awareness and encouragement of campus recycling;


Whereas, this group is responsible for implementation of the Spot-A-Mug program that promotes the use of reusable mugs on campus;

Whereas, an ASUCD senate bill was passed that will attempt to divert pre-consumer food from all food operations to the Student Farm for composting;

Whereas, in calendar year 2000, R4 diverted 234.95 tons of cardboard; 517.36 tons of paper; 195.5 tons of glass, cans and bottles; 432.41 tons of scrap metal; 195.5 tons of green waste; 29.1 tons of wood pallets; and 1,636.34 tons of straw and manure;

Now, therefore, I, Ken Wagstaff, Mayor of Davis, on behalf of the city council and the citizens of Davis, present the 2001 Environmental Recognition Award to the R4 Recycling Program - UCD in recognition of its environmental contributions to the Davis community.
