You can recycle your empty inkjet and toner cartridges on campus.

### Inkjet Cartridges

1. Put the empty cartridge in a small box (to prevent leakage).
2. Place in an inter-campus mail envelope and send to:

### Toner Cartridges

1. Place the empty cartridge in its original box (or any box) **NOT** an envelope.
2. Send through inter-campus mail to:

**Mail Services**  
**Label it: Toner Recycle**
